3. Why do you think the Holy Spirit is often the most “forgotten” person of the Trinity?

4. Have you ever felt convicted, comforted, or guided in a way you think might have been the Holy Spirit? What happened?

DIGGING DEEPER

Read John 14:15-26; 16:7-14

1. What does Jesus mean by “another advocate”? How is the Holy Spirit similar to Jesus and how is the Holy Spirit different from Jesus?

2. Why was it so important for Jesus to leave and send us another Advocate – and why is it just as important for us to know the Holy Spirit as it is to know Jesus?

3. How does the Holy Spirit teach and remind us of Jesus' words in practical ways?

4. How do you recognize the difference between the Spirit's guidance verses your own thoughts or feelings?

5. Jesus says the Spirit will glorify Him. How does the Holy Spirit make Jesus clear, near, and dear to us?

6. How might relying on the Holy Spirit change the way we pray, read Scripture, or share our faith?

TAKE IT HOME

1. How could you begin to invite the Holy Spirit into your decisions this week?

2. What practices could help you create more space to hear and respond to the Spirit's voice (e.g., prayer, quiet time, obedience, Scripture meditation)?

3. How can we learn to communicate with the Holy Spirit as a person, not just as a presence?
