## Hosting a Group

How to become a Groups host.



#### Why Groups?

To be the Church beyond Sunday.

We believe that Church was never meant to just be one day a week.

God has called each of us to be the Church, His hands, and His feet in ALL that we do.

Groups provide an opportunity for connection, care, and Christ-centred growth to impact us beyond Sunday.

### Why host a Group?

Hosting gives you the opportunity to utilize the gifts & passions God has given you to create fun, safe, and loving spaces for others to join real community.

There are three key elements behind being a Groups host at North Pointe.

## Who you are.

- Be a consistent attendee of North Pointe (1 year).
- Show integrity and character.
- Have evident spiritual maturity.
- High care and concern for others.
- Commitment to reliability (minimal meeting cancellation, prepared to lead each meeting).
- Represent North Pointe positively and with protection of its unity (needs to reflect NP Mission & Vision statements, NP values).
- Undergo application and interview.

# How to meet.

- Start and end times are important (respect for people's time).
- Weekly group communication through email or text (whichever works best for group as a whole).
- Groups and meeting locations must align with the values and beliefs of North Pointe. (i.e. Groups shouldn't meet in bars, clubs, casinos, etc.)
- Meetings must include 3 or more people (Who can you ask to be part of this with you?).
- Groups can meet as often as they desire, but must be consistent (Monthly meetings are the minimum requirement).

# How to lead.

- Hosts need to be willing to create a place where group members can find care and support.
- Facilitate an environment where group members can safely express fears, worries, and doubts about faith and life.
- Host's responsibility to stop gossip or destructive conversation immediately.
- Zero tolerance policy for self-promotion (politics, small business, MLM, etc.)
- Study-based groups are fact-focused, not opinion-focused. Communicate observable facts/ideas. (If you can't weigh it, don't say it).
- Hosts are willing to connect with group members outside of meeting times to produce genuine community.
- Hosts are supported by a Groups coach to help with any questions or concerns.
